Serenity Villa is a household (small house) memory support care home. 20-22 people have the opportunity to reside there with a dedicated team of memory support caregivers to love and serve them.

Serenity Villa has been intentionally designed as a home with special features of a memory care environment. Clustered in front of the house are the central living spaces: kitchen, living room, dining room, sunroom and sensory room. A lovely enclosed courtyard is accessible from the sunroom and from each hallway. Twenty apartments - built in a square around the courtyard - feature private living area, bathrooms with showers, large closets, mini refrigerator/freezer and call system for assistance.

Serenity Villa also includes the special features of a memory care environment, such as:

- ◆ natural walking paths indoors and outdoors
- ◆ natural diffused lighting
- ◆ special touches to create a serene, peaceful setting
- ◆ enjoying nature in secure outdoors areas
- ◆ reduced noise

As the Fairview Haven team researched the best options for people with dementia, we learned that the household (small house) model is far superior to the traditional nursing home, especially for dementia care.

“The household model is defined as: Small groups of people sharing house and home while directing their own daily lives... The household is each person’s home and sanctuary. The physical building is designed to be a true home.”¹
In a household, people and caregivers bond as a family. People with dementia thrive in smaller, quieter environments that are more like their own homes.

Elements of home at Serenity Villa include:

- ◆ an open kitchen where people can cook together
 “A kitchen is the heart of the home.”¹
- ◆ a hearth and living room
- ◆ family-style dining
- ◆ private rooms and bathrooms
- ◆ bathing spa
- ◆ residential laundry
- ◆ attached garage
- ◆ welcoming front door and front porch
- ◆ interior courtyard with easy access
